1st Grade Families

Welcome to first grade! Your teachers are looking forward to a wonderful school year. We would like to invite you to our first grade "Meet and Greet" on Wednesday, August 3rd, from 12-1pm. Classroom assignments will be posted prior to Wednesday, so you will know which classroom to visit. Mrs. Perkins is in room E-1, Mrs. Evans is in room E-2, and Mrs. McNickle and Mrs. Coleman are in room E-3. 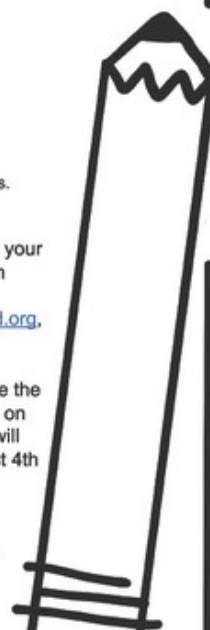
Please bring in your school supplies at this time so we can sort them. This makes the first day of school much smoother! Some items will go in the child's pencil box, some are saved for later, and some are community supplies. The supplies your first grader needs are:

- 1 box #2 pencils sharpened (Ticonderoga)
- 2 boxes of 16-24 crayons (standard colors)
- 1 package of large glue sticks
- *Scissors
- *4 Pentel Hi-Polymer white erasers
- *Pencil box (snap-top) standard size only, approx. 8x5
- Backpack
- *Write your child's first name, with a black Sharpie, on the starred items. Sharpies will be available in the classroom if needed.



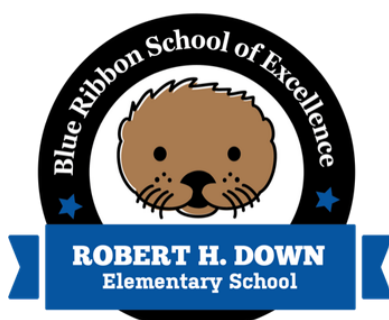
