Dear RHD Families -

With our year getting closer to the end of our first month, I wanted to share some important volunteer opportunities that have helped RHD provide excellent, free after school programs as well as some safety issues where parents/guardians can help support safety and student fun.

- Drama Club (<u>robertdowndrama@gmail.com</u>): Mondays and Wednesdays after school for 4th and 5th grades. Director Rozsa is going to work with previous drama students first to help train them working with other students.
- Lego Club (Kinder-3rd): No Set days as parents are needed.
- Lego Robotics (4th and 5th): Tuesdays with Mr. Villagomez in the computer lab.
- Garden Beds: Four new beds still need to placed with a crew of at least four-six adults. Please reach out to Mr. Keller if you have an open Saturday morning until noon.
- Before School Drop off, gate monitoring, playground play monitoring contact Mr. Keller if you are available on a regular basis to monitor gates or the playground for children to enter and get the wiggles out before the bell. This can only occur if a solid group of adults volunteer in the morning. Training will occur.
- After School Pick Up, gate monitoring: Contact Mr. Keller if you are available for making sure no adults enter the campus after the school bell rings. Training will occur.


