
Before coming to campus to volunteer, please check with your child's teacher to schedule a time that works best for them.

Katherine Applegate's newest book *Odder* is based on the work of the Monterey Bay Aquarium's Sea Otter Research and Conservation (SORAC) program. In concert with the book's release the publisher is sponsoring a nation-wide coin drive, **Make Waves with Odder**, to raise funds for this program.

Make Waves with Odder is designed to inspire the next generation of conservationists. Otters are a keystone species, meaning they play a critical role in maintaining the ecological health of the places where they live. 
