#### Principal's Message

Dear RHD Families -

#### **Holiday Program Plans**

I hope everyone had a wonderful Thanksgiving Break. The days seem to be speeding, and soon we will be celebrating holiday traditions from around the world at our annual performance. Earlier this week, the 14-day forecast listed thunderstorms, so we have a contingency plan just in case Tuesday, Dec. 13th brings inclement weather like today. More recent forecasts have provided better weather.

<u>Plan A</u>: Tuesday, Dec. 13th - Holiday Program at Pacific Grove High School's Breaker's Stadium (Corner of Sunset Drive and Congress Ave.). Several information sheets are below to provide families where to park, student drop off locations, classroom sitting locations on the track, and pick up. There are other pictures to help families with locations of drop off and pick up from last year.

Regardless of the location, our program will be lots of fun, so make plans to attend and be prepared for cold weather if we are at the stadium.

### **Holiday Program Parking**

- PGHS parking lot off Sunset near the baseball field
- Sunset Drive and Congress Ave.
- Off Forest Lodge Road in the shared parking lot between PGHS and Forest Grove Elementary
- We ask that the stadium parking (access through Forest Grove/Congress) be saved for the Disabled and family members with walking concerns.
- Forest Grove staff parking will be reserved for FG & RHD employees.

#### A few things to remember for that night:

- The PGHS track does not support high heels so please wear flats or pumps if you plan to come onto the track for student pick up.
- Students will sit on the track with their grade level in their homeroom class. Students may want to use a jacket or small blanket to sit on.
- Students will need to stay until the end of the performance. All grades will perform on Monday, Dec. 12th (Forest Grove) and Tuesday, Dec. 13th (Robert H. Down) Weather forecast is mid 50s to low 60s.
- Photo opportunities will be available but please bring that zoom lens if you have one. There may be folks in wheelchairs watching from the track level no one should stand in front of these attendees. Families are welcome to bring folding chairs if it is difficult to climb the ramp or stairs into the stadium seats.
- This will be a time for our Otter Ohana to come together safely to celebrate our shared holiday traditions along with learning
  from each other about different cultural celebrations. Please keep a safe distance from each other in the stands and work together
  while selecting seating arrangements. Be warm with each other in spirit and remember that we all need to be supported.


#### Estacionamiento del programa de vacaciones

- Estacionamiento de PGHS en la calle Sunset cerca del campo de béisbol
- Calle Sunset y avenida Congreso.
- Fuera de Forest Lodge Road en el estacionamiento compartido entre PGHS y la primaria Forest Grove
- Pedimos que el estacionamiento del estadio (acceso a través de Forest Grove/Congress) sea reservado para los discapacitados y los miembros de la familia con problemas para caminar.
- El estacionamiento del personal de Forest Grove estará reservado para los empleados de FG y RHD.

#### Algunas cosas para recordar esa noche:

- La pista de PGHS no admite tacones altos, así que use zapatos planos o de tacón si planea venir a la pista para recoger a los estudiantes.
- Los estudiantes se sentarán en la pista con su clase principal junto con el mismo nivel de clase. Los estudiantes podrían usar una chaqueta o una manta pequeña para sentarse.

### **Health Department Announcement**

#### Health Department and Area Hospitals Urge Monterey County Residents to Take Preventative Measures Against Winter Respiratory Viruses

Community Hospital of the Monterey Peninsula, Mee Memorial Healthcare System, Natividad Medical Center, Salinas Valley Memorial Hospital, and the Monterey County Health Department urge all residents to act now to protect themselves and their families against respiratory viruses circulating this holiday season, including influenza ("flu"), COVID-19, and respiratory syncytial virus (RSV). An early wave of RSV and influenza activity in California has led to increased hospitalizations among children in many places across the state, placing stress on the healthcare system.

Monterey County hospitals are not Pediatric Intensive Care Unit hospitals and are working with regional hospitals to transfer critical care pediatric patients. These critical care hospitals are also near capacity.

In at least two Monterey County hospitals, the number of pediatric patients with respiratory symptoms visiting the Emergency Departments has more than doubled. Local hospitals and the Health Department ask for everyone's help keeping our children and families safe heading into the winter season by following these five steps:

- Get Vaccinated and Boosted. Influenza and COVID-19 vaccines continue to provide the best protection against severe illness and death. You can get both vaccines at the same time.
   Everyone 6 months of age and older should get up to date on their flu and COVID-19 vaccinations now.
- Stay Home if You Are Sick. When you are sick, avoid close contact with others to protect them and to take the time you need to heal.
- Wear a Mask. There is no vaccine for RSV. Wearing a mask can significantly slow the spread of RSV and protect babies and young children who do not yet have immunity. You can spread illness before you start feeling sick. Wearing a mask in indoor public places protects others who might be more medically vulnerable.
- Wash Your Hands. Frequent handwashing with soap and warm water is an easy way to stay healthy and keep from spreading germs.
- Cover Your Cough or sneeze with your elbow, arm, or a disposable tissue to help prevent the spread of winter viruses.

Community Hospital of the Monterey Peninsula, Mee Memorial Health Care System, Natividad Medical Center, Salinas Valley Memorial Hospital, and the Monterey County Health Department urge residents to take these measures to help our hospitals have the capacity to care for all Monterey County residents this winter.

#### El Departamento de Salud y los hospitales locales urgen a los residentes del condado de Monterey a tomar medidas preventivas contra los virus respiratorios del invierno

El Hospital Community Hospital of the Monterey Peninsula, el Mee Memorial Healthcare System, el Centro Médico Natividad, el Hospital Salinas Valley Memorial y el Departamento de Salud del Condado de Monterey urgen a todos los residentes a actuar ahora para protegerse a sí mismos y a sus familias contra los virus respiratorios que circulan en esta temporada de fiestas, incluyendo la influenza ("gripe"), el COVID-19 y el virus sincitial respiratorio (VRS). La primera ola de actividad del VRS y de la gripe en California ha provocado un aumento de las hospitalizaciones entre los niños en muchos lugares del estado, lo que ha puesto a prueba el sistema sanitario.

Los hospitales del Condado de Monterey no son hospitales de la Unidad de Cuidados Intensivos Pediátricos y están trabajando con los hospitales del área de la Bahía para trasladar a los pacientes pediátricos de cuidados intensivos. Estos hospitales de cuidados intensivos también están cerca de su máxima capacidad.

En al menos dos hospitales del condado de Monterey, el número de pacientes pediátricos con síntomas respiratorios que visitan los departamentos de emergencia se ha duplicado. Los hospitales locales y el Departamento de Salud piden la ayuda de todos para mantener a nuestros niños y familias seguros de cara a la temporada de invierno siguiendo estos cinco pasos:

- Vacúnate y ponte la vacuna de refuerzo. Las vacunas contra la gripe y el COVID-19 siguen proporcionando la mejor protección contra las enfermedades graves y la muerte. Puedes ponerte las dos vacunas al mismo tiempo. Todas las personas de 6 meses en adelante deben ponerse al día con las vacunas contra la gripe y contra el COVID-19 ahora.
- Quédate en casa si estás enfermo. Cuando estés enfermo, evita el contacto cercano con los demás para protegerlos y para tomarte el tiempo que necesitas para curarte.
- **Utiliza una mascarilla.** No hay vacuna para el VRS. Llevar una mascarilla puede ralentizar considerablemente la propagación del VRS y proteger a los bebés y niños pequeños que aún no tienen inmunidad. La enfermedad se puede propagar antes de que empiecen los síntomas. Llevar una mascarilla en lugares públicos cerrados protege a las personas más vulnerables.
- Lávate las manos. Lavarse las manos con frecuencia con agua tibia y jabón es una forma sencilla de mantenerse sano y evitar la propagación de gérmenes.
- Al toser o estornudar, cúbrete con el codo, el brazo o un pañuelo desechable para evitar la propagación de los virus invernales.

El hospital Community Hospital of the Monterey Peninsula, el Mee Memorial Healthcare System, el centro médico Natividad, el hospital Salinas Valley Memorial y el departamento de salud del condado de Monterey urgen a los residentes a tomar estas medidas para ayudar a nuestros hospitales a tener la capacidad de atender a todos los residentes del condado de Monterey este invierno..




